Tri-M Benefit Concert for the Lao Wang Orphanage

Teachers Band 'Mamahuhu' In order to raise medical funds to provide vital surgeries for Chinese orphans, the Tri-M Music Honor Society Chapter of the Shanghai American School Puxi staged a benefit concert on November 6th, 2010.



The 'Music for Hope' concert at the Performing Arts Center of the Shanghai American School was a great success. Throughout four hours of multifarious entertainment and a silent auction, the concert carried in about 80 000 RMB.

Not only students but also professionals and even teachers were part of the concert's diverting program. Several music bands performing Rock, Pop, Classic and Jazz, choirs and Chinese traditional music catered for all tastes. There were funny moments with the very entertaining student bands and 'Mamahuhu', the teachers band, just recently founded for this occasion. And there were also artistic highlights with the Jazz Pianist Mavis Pan and the Shanghai International String Quartet.

About two-thirds of the orphans are somehow disabled and need surgeries, either to save or improve their lives. With the whole income of the benefit concert severe surgeries will be provided.
